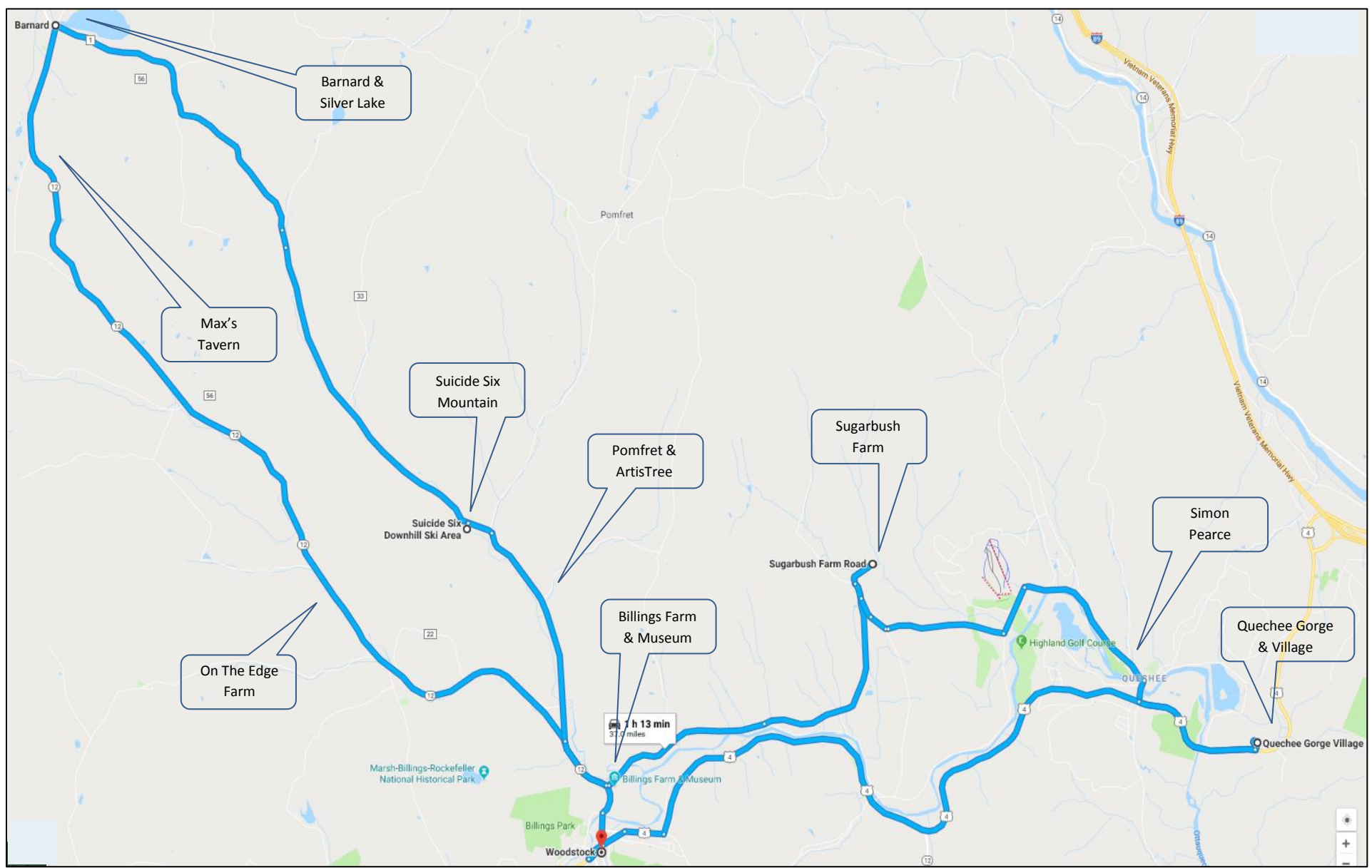




The Wonderful Woodstock Foliage Drive

A little over an hour (without stops)



Directions and things to do as you enjoy the many beautiful fall sceneries

Make a left as you exit the Woodstocker B&B

Head straight down River Street via a very slight left so as not to cross the Route 4 bridge

Keep going straight on River Street and at the second stop sign make a left towards Billings Farm and Museum

Follow Route 12 North towards Barnard

Things to do on Route 12

Visit of Billings Farm and Museum before you start your journey on route 12

A stop at On The Edge Farmstand to check out their yummy products

Something to eat or drink at Max's Tavern in the Barnard Inn (Wed/Sat, 5pm-9pm)

Check out the Barnard General Store on the edge of Silver Lake

Take Route 1, Stage Road (make a right onto Stage Road from Route 12, at the General Store)

Stay on Stage Road, it will bear right at a fork... don't miss it !

Note: You may also make a stop at Silver Lake State Park (if so it's a left onto Stage Road when returning from your visit)

Things to do on Route 1

In season: Consider a stop at Suicide 6 Mountain to check out fun mountain biking activities

Perhaps a temporary stop at ArtisTree Community Arts Center (left onto Pomfret Road)

Go back onto Pomfret Road towards Woodstock, you will also see Teago General Store

Rejoin Route 12 South and make a left at Billings Farm onto Old River Road

Things to do while heading to Quechee

Make a left onto High Pastures Road

Make a slight right onto Sugarbush Farm Road

Enjoy Sugarbush Farm (cheddar cheeses, maple syrup, horses, farm animals...)

After leaving the farm, rejoin Spaulding Lane (slight left) then Hillside Road towards Quechee

Make a left on Quechee Main Street

Visit Simon Pearce Glass and check out the view from their restaurant and the glass blowers

Cross the covered bridge onto Waterman Hill Road

Turn left onto Route 4 East

Take in the scenery at Quechee Gorge (you can also park and visit – check out the Segway Personal Transporter Tours)

Continue to Quechee Gorge Village for some shopping and antiquing

Return to Woodstock and the Woodstocker B&B via Route 4 West

Another Option: Back Roads Foliage Fun

Less than 30 minutes to destination

Make a left upon exiting the Woodstocker's driveway

Drive through Woodstock on Route 4 East

At Maplefields, leave Route 4 and continue straight onto Hartland Hill Road for 3.6 miles

Bear right onto Town Farm Hill Road and stay on that road until the end

Turn left onto Brownsville Road (to your left is the Skunk Hollow Tavern)

Turn right onto Route 12 South and in Hartland make a right to stay onto Route 12 towards Windsor (cross I 91, you will see Simon Pearce Glass to your right)

Make a left onto Ruth Carney Drive

Turn left onto Artisan Way

You will see Blake Hill Preserves (jam tasting), Silo Distillery, Harpoon Brewery and Vermont Farmstead Chees Market

Then return to Woodstock
